2019 KCRQF Guild Quilts - Rules

How to enter:

- 1. Entrants must be a member of a Participating Guild in order to enter a quilt.
- 2. Entrants must enter their cloth quilt by submitting a completed and signed entry form and two (2) photographs to their own Guild Registration Committee.
- 3. There is no entry fee for Guild Showcase quilts.
- 4. Selection of Guild Showcase quilts to be entered into the Festival is the responsibility of each Guild. However, Festival Board reserves the right to reject any entry deemed objectionable or too controversial.
- 5. Each Guild's Registration Committee shall submit entry forms and photos to the Festival Registration Committee between March 1, 2019 and March 31, 2019.
- 6. All Guild Showcase quilts shall be delivered and picked up as a group by the Guild Registration Committee. No individual shall be allowed to deliver or pickup their own quilts.

Quilt Specifications:

- 7. Entrant must have significantly participated in the making of the quilt top and/or the quilting.
- 8. All quilts must be quilted by hand or machine. Quilting is defined as a running stitch that passes through the top, batting and backing. Tied or tacked quilts are not eligible.
- 9. Crafted items such as garments, bags, etc. are not eligible.
- 10. Quilts must have been completed in the years 2016 2019.
- 11. Quilts previously displayed at KCRQF are not eligible except by special invitation. Between 24" 96" on any side.
- 12. All quilts must have a sewn-on label securely attached to the back of the quilt. Pinned labels are not accepted. Back, lower-left corner placement is preferred.
- 13. All quilts must have a 4 inch open ended sleeve for hanging. Sleeve must be securely sewn to the quilt. Pinned sleeves or sleeves less than 4 inches will not be accepted. http://www.quiltweek.com/hanging-sleeve-instructions/
- 14. All quilts must fit the size requirements noted in the category descriptions:
- 15. You must select an appropriate category on the entry form in which to place your quilt. Each entry form must be completely filled in and two (2) pictures must be included.
- 16. Quilts must be in excellent condition. Incomplete, torn, soiled or quilts with strong odors or animal hair will not qualify for entry or display.
- 17. Entry must be in a single, stand-alone project. No guarantee can be made that any quilt can be hung along with any other quilt. It may not be framed, mounted or covered.
- 18. Quilts embellished with sharp objects that may be hazardous to volunteers or visitors will not be accepted.

- 19. Quilts must be able to be folded, rolled or stacked. Special handling due to ruching, beading or other embellishments is not available.
- 20. Each quilt must be delivered to the festival in a clear plastic bag. Taped on the bag should be the name of the participating guild. Inside the bag should be a copy of the registration form and a picture of the quilt. Every effort will be made to return the bag to the participating guild.

General:

- 21. No substitution of the original entry shall be allowed.
- 21 Categories with fewer than five (5) entries may be canceled.
- 22 All entries must remain on display for the duration of the show.
- 23 Awards will be given for 1st through 3rd place in each category plus Viewer's Choice. All by vote of Festival attendees.
- 24 Award decisions are final.
- 25 KCRQF reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate or which fails to meet entry requirements.
- 26 Any quilt not picked up at the end of the Festival will be removed by the Festival Registration Chairs and the Guild contracted to retrieve the quilt.
