

2019 Starlight Quilters Guild Challenge ROUND & FOUND

Make a quilt that is ROUND, like a circle. The circle should be no less than 12" and no more than 24" in diameter (across the middle). You may put anything you want inside the circle, but it must include something that you have FOUND. The found object can be anything. A piece of fabric that you found. (Really? You can do better than that.)

Or a rock that you found in your shoe. A treasure you found when you were a kid. A piece of ribbon that means a lot to you. Anything that you found that you thought was interesting or odd. The circle may be pieced or appliquéd.

Details:

It must be round - no angles.

It must be a quilt - two layers of fabric with batting in between and the whole sandwich stitched together or tied.

It must include a found object.

Minimum diameter is 12" and the maximum diameter is 24".

This challenge will end with the September guild meeting. Challenge quilts will be displayed and voted on by members present at the meeting. You are encouraged to enter your challenge quilt in the Starlight Quilt Show.
