

SQG Board Meeting Minutes
November 5, 2020

The meeting was called to order by President Jean Turvey. The meeting was called to order by Jean Turvey, President.

Treasurer's Report & Discussion of 2021 Budget

- Dana reported that we will operate at a loss this year due to membership dues being delayed until next year, no quilt show, and no income from the buckets each month. Expenses have decreased also due to no meeting space rent or setup/take down expenses so the overall deficit will not be terribly large. Discussion regarding 2021 budget follows.
- Membership – 60 members paid this year and will be credited to next year. Anticipate 45 additional memberships paid in 2021. Membership year is April-March. Discussion about limiting access to zoom programs to those who have paid membership starting with the new membership year in April. Newsletter could be distributed to all who are members in 2020.
- Quilt Show – budgeting 250 admissions @ \$5 each. Expenses will be based on 2019 numbers.
- Buckets – no budget needs
- Community Service & Project Linus – no budget needs
- Programs – budget request of \$5,000
- Door Prizes – same as 2020

Money Market Account

- Carla Orner moved and Judy Danz seconded that we move the money from the money market account into the checking account so there is only one account to manage. The interest from the money market acct is negligible.

Quilt Show

- Discussion was held regarding changing the quilt show from yearly to every other year.
 - Opposite the festival year?
 - Decision to do this should be put to vote of the entire guild.
 - Quilt show planning should really be a two year project so planning for the 2022 show should start now.
 - No major decision will be made at this time. A quilt show will be held in 2021 and 2022.
 - Janette Sheldon volunteered to be the chairperson of the 2022 quilt show.
- Officers and Committee Chairpersons – Two vacancies exist – Vice-President and workshops.
- Committee Reports –
 - A donation was received for members to use to have quilting done for the KU Cancer Center project. This money will go into the treasury and members will need to ask for reimbursement. Reimbursement limit is \$50/quilt and the quilting should be done by a SQG member.
 - Renee Arnett has volunteered to chair the sale of the Opportunity Quilt tickets for next year.

- Openings are available for the workshop on the 18th.
- The UFO lists for this year will continue through the end of December. New lists will be collected in January.
- Dana has a new mailing address.
- Reports for the November newsletter are due ASAP.
