**Move to new location:**

Michelle Cour found a new location for our monthly guild meetings at Overland Park Lutheran Church, 7810 West 79<sup>th</sup> Street, Overland Park, Kansas. An email went out to the board members on January 5th about the location and asked for votes from the board members. Sandy Fey, Sue Howard, Janette Sheldon, Linda Clatterbuck, and Rosie Brinker have all seen the location and had nothing but great comments to say about it. The biggest advantage is that the rent is only \$75 per meeting saving the guild about \$125 a month. The only drawback was there was no ice machine. There was an overwhelming vote of “yes” to the new location by email. A one year contract has been signed. The contract states that the church will give the guild three months notice in the event we need to vacate the location.

**Needs for storage at the new location:**

The guild will be purchasing three new movable cabinets from Sam's Wholesale Club For \$209 each to replace the cabinets we currently have. We will be donating the current cabinets to Countryside Christian Church. These new movable cabinets will be used to store the library books, the plates, napkins, cups, etc. for the hospitality committee, a small box of supplies for the membership committee, and the Accuquilt machine. To help save space in these cabinets Sue Howard volunteered to scan the information in the historian books to a disc and then discard the books. It was suggested if every member could take home a handful of books at the January meeting (on their honor) then bring them back at the February meeting it would help with the move. The library will be closed at the February meeting.

Donna will make up a flyer to hand out at the January meeting about the move to include the address, directions, etc. of the new location for the members.

Another member will post a flyer on the door of the Countryside Christian Church in January, February and March advising about the move.

Janette Sheldon made a motion to spend over the budgeted amount for the movable cabinets.  
Connie Passaro seconded the motion  
All board members were in favor.

The next board meeting will be at the Antioch Library on April 18 at 6:30.
