Pot Luck – Helpers; Schedule:

We discussed the time allotments for the October program. Dinner at 6:30, UFO's and the program to present our favorite tools to be presented at around 7:30. It was estimated that there would be around 60-80 people at the pot luck dinner.

Quilt Show Review: will we have a show next year:

25 grids were purchased this year for the quilt show along with 2 that were purchased at a garage sale. The cost came to more than what was budgeted. The board agreed to move the proposed budgeted expense of \$583.41 from the quilt show column for supplies/racks to the column for administration/furniture/fixtures. This will give us a profit of \$3,21.38 for the quilt show in lieu of \$2,657.97.

Janette Sheldon made a motion to have a quilt show in 2017 and it was seconded by Jackie Rudolph. Kim Cawthon and Janette Sheldon volunteered to chair the quilt show in 2017. Tina Darrow also volunteered to chair the boutique for the show in 2017. The board will reach out to the Abdallah Shrine Temple to secure the venue for the show next year.

In regards to the KCRQF show in 2017 our guild will be providing hospitality for volunteers only. We can only make money from the sale of tickets for the opportunity quilt since there will not be any individual booths with items to sell next year. The show will be grander in size than the one last year. There will be more classroom space. The vendors will also be charged more for their space.

Moving issue – do we move? Next Step:

We will be requesting a quote from the Countryside Christian Church for our meeting space in 2017. We will hang tight at the present location until we can form another committee to look for an additional

space. It was suggested that we should try to reach out to the sewing club that meets at the Unitarian Universalist Church to come to our meetings and join our guild. This may help us to secure this space in the future.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer – Sue Howard reported that she needs any updates to the budget by November 7th.

Membership – Donna di Natale was not at the meeting but she relayed by messenger that we now have 140 members as of October.

Library – Cheryl Tomson mentioned that we will be needing another volunteer to help in the library next year because Linda Clatterbuck will be stepping down.

Bucket Brigade – Deb McCurnin and Beverly Renner both volunteered to do the bucket raffle again next year.

Workshops – Cassie Schwarz and Chris Haubein will not be doing workshops in 2017. **We need someone to fill this position.**

Guild Project – Victoria Foley said that she has received 89 aprons so far. Linda Clatterbuck has volunteered to do the guild project next year.

Opportunity Quilt - Ann Doherty reported that we raised \$96 from the sale of tickets at the show. We have collected a total of \$600 so far. To increase this amount, it was discussed for the future that every member be given a pack of tickets to sell or purchase themselves. It was also suggested that we need to purchase new racks to display the opportunity quilt.
