Committee Reports:

Treasurer – Janette volunteered to perform an audit of the treasurer books again this year.

Fundraising/Raffle – Deb mentioned that we as a guild should “give back” more to guild members in the future since we are a nonprofit group. Programs – Donna and Sandy are working on the programs for 2018. They will be passing out a survey at the meeting next week to get ideas from the members of what topics for programs and workshops

they are interested in. They have 4 speakers booked already for next year with two waiting on contracts and dates. They may have Edyta Sitar booked for May/2019 since she will be in KC that year for spring market. Renee has been working on trying to find a place for Edyta to have her trunk show and workshop. Her preliminary research for a location that can accommodate a crowd of 150+ included – Nelson Atkins, Kauffman Conference Center, Johnson County Community College, Johnson County Arts & Heritage Center, Mission Theatre, Matt Ross Community Center and Sylvester Powell Jr. Community Center.
