Committee Reports:

Programs/Workshops - Donna di Natale - The dates have been booked for the 2018 quilt show. They are September 27 (set up); September 28 & 29 (show) from 9:30 to 5:00 each day.

Opportunity Quilt - it was suggested that instead of raffling off a quilt next year we should consider raffling one of Donna di Natale's featherweight sewing machines.

Community Project - Linda Clatterbuck was not present but she sent a note stating that we made 190 placemats this year for the Shawnee Mission Meals on Wheels. The clients were very excited to get such beautiful placepats. A lot of members participated and they did wonderful work.

Treasurer- Sue Howard asked if we should renew the \$40 dues for the support network. It was agreed by the board to renew as this network is helpful in selecting speakers for the guild meetings.

Programs - Sandy Fey and Donna di Natale indicated that they have filled all the months speakers for 2018 except for October. They have invited a speaker but have not received a response yet. If there is no response, they will have a pot luck that month. They have booked Lenexa Community Center for the workshop in January featuring Amy Bradley. The maximum participants is 25 for this workshop. Donna said they are planning on having about six workshops next year. Budget - Sue Howard reported that the budget for 2018 is about the same as 2017. Workshops budget will be increased from \$1,000 to \$2,000. Because we are expecting a large attendance for her lecture we need to reserve a larger venue and we will need to pay a reservation (down payment) fee in 2018 to hold our 2019 reservation. The supplies for Project Linus will be reduced from \$300 to \$200. Mary Funk made a motion to approve the budget as discussed. The motion was seconded by Deb McCurnin and passed by the board.
