

Block 2—Optional Directions

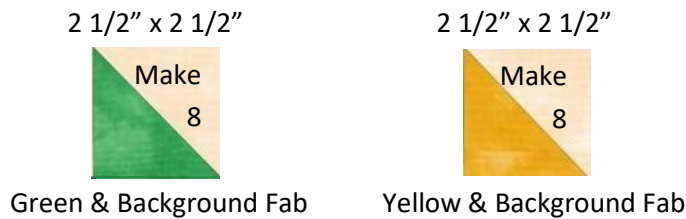
Please read all the directions and look at the finished block before you put rotary cutter to fabric.

** Fabric and Colors—Again, these colors are used for pattern and placement only.*

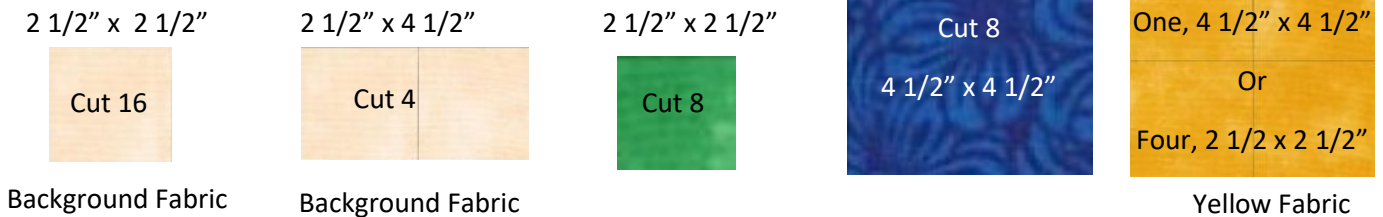
You may want a focus fabric or a 4 patch in the center

Half Square Triangles: Using whatever method you're most comfortable with—make the following HST's.

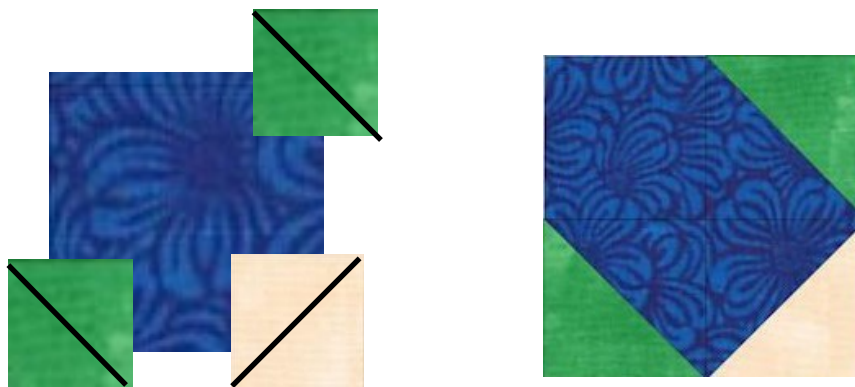
2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (2-inch finished in block)



Additional units in Block:

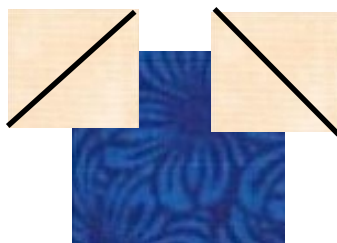


Using: One blue 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square, 2 green 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" and 1 background 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" squares, build the following block—Much like making a snow ball block, sew on the diagonal of 3 corners



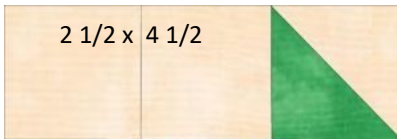
Make a total of 4 block units, each should measure 4 1/2 x 4 1/2" each

With remaining Four, 4 1/2 x 4 1/2" blue squares, plus Eight 2 1/2 x 2 1/2" squares, make the following unit.

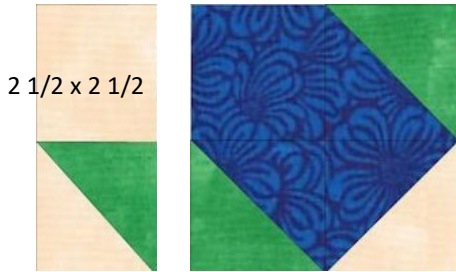


Make a total of 4 block units, each should measure 4 1/2 x 4 1/2"

Unit Assembly: Add HST's and background units for corner blocks.

For Center Unit: Add 2 yellow HST

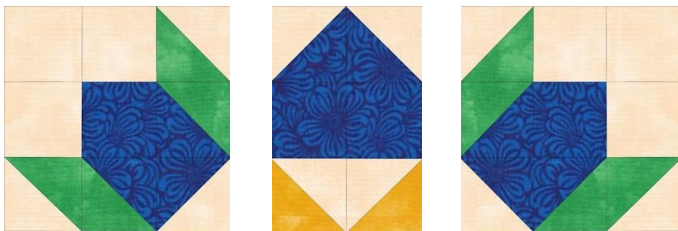


Make a total

Center units

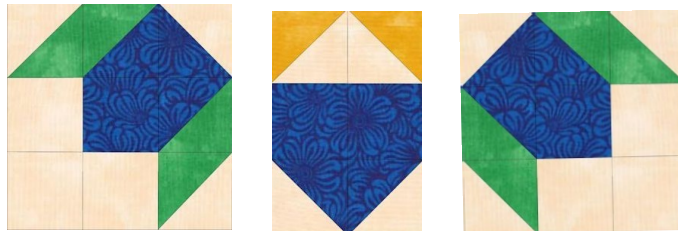


Block Assembly:

16 1/2 x 16 1/2"
