

Block 3

Background Fabric—cut Two squares $6\frac{1}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{4}''$ inches, One strip $3'' \times 24''$

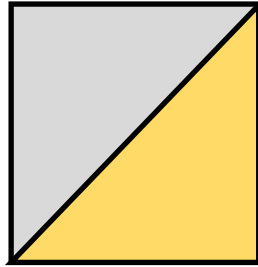
Yellow Fabric—cut Two squares $6\frac{1}{4}'' \times 6\frac{1}{4}''$, One strip $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 24''$

Red Fabric—cut Four squares $3'' \times 3''$, one strip $1\frac{3}{4}'' \times 24''$

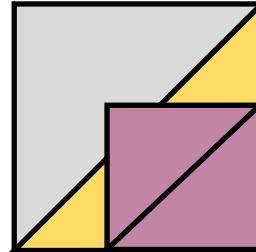
Center unit— cut One $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 6\frac{1}{2}''$, with Background or Focus fabric.

Corner Unit Assembly:

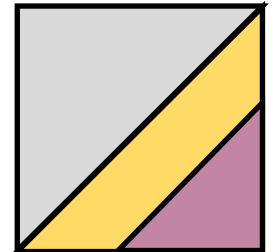
With a Background and a Yellow square, draw line on the back and sew scant $\frac{1}{4}''$ seam, make 2 HST's - do for both squares for total of 4 HST's. Trim to $5\frac{1}{2}''$



Now add the $3''$ Red square to the corner for all 4 units.

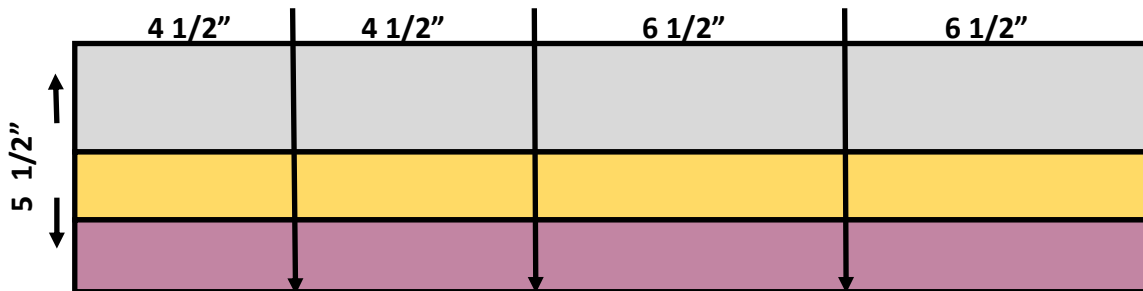


You should have 4 finished units, measuring $5\frac{1}{2}''$



Strip Assembly:

With the Strips of background, yellow and red fabric, strip piece together in the color order below—or in your color choice order. Sub-cut and Trim to $5\frac{1}{2}''$ inch by noted measurements below. Trim off background side.



Row/Block Assembly:

For Row 1 and Row 3, use Two $5\frac{1}{2}''$ square units and One $4\frac{1}{2}''$ strip unit.

For Row 2, center row—use Two $6\frac{1}{2}''$ inch strip units and the background or focus fabric unit

Block should measure

$14\frac{1}{2}'' \times 16\frac{1}{2}''$
