

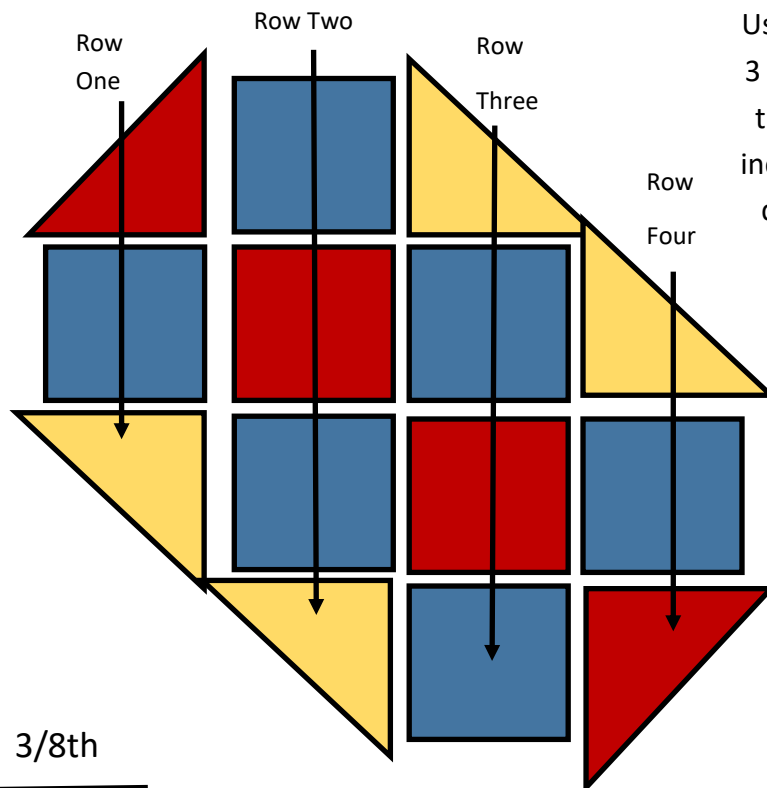
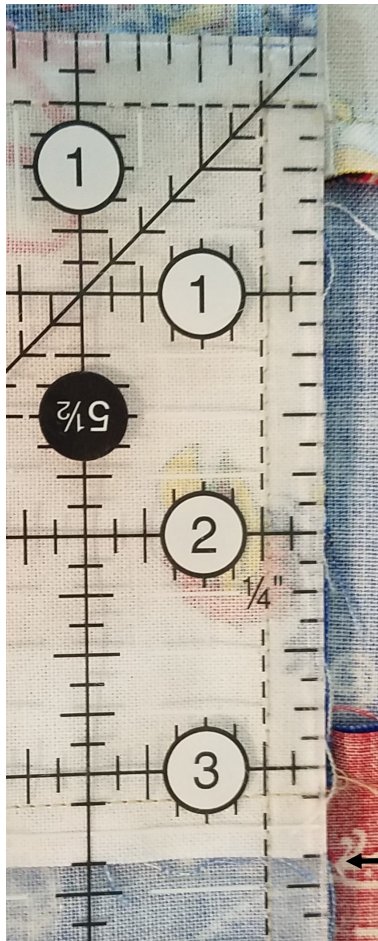
Block 5— Optional - replace a Color/Yellow with your background fabric

Yellow Fabric—cut **Two**, 4 inch squares, then cut on the diagonal for 4 halves. Cut **Two**, 3 inches blocks and cut on the diagonal for 4 halves

Blue Fabric—cut **Six**, 3 3/8 squares

Red Fabric—cut **Two**, 3 3/8 squares, cut **One**, 4 inch square and cut on the diagonal.

Please take no offense, but I'm ruler challenged and wanted to show an example.



Using the Blue and Red 3 3/8 inch squares and the Red and Yellow 4 inch squares cut on the diagonal—assemble rows as shown.

3/8th

12 1/2 inches

Once you've sewn together your rows, then add row 1 to row 2, adding each row until they're all together. Using the Two 3 inch yellow squares cut on the diagonal, sew to the blue squares on each of the 4 corners.

Once your block is complete, square up to 12 1/2 x 8 1/2, making sure not to cut too much off one side.
