

2021 BOM—Finishing Instructions

With the Cancer Center lap quilt donation size in mind, I designed this quilt to finish 44" x 50". For myself, I made 2 lap quilts—one without a border for donation and the second with a border as my keeper. I'm only including finishing instructions on the 44" x 50" size.

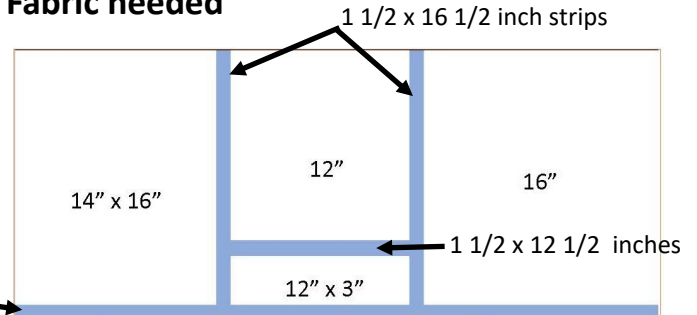
Adding the Sashing—less than 1/2 yard of Fabric needed

Section 1: Top Third

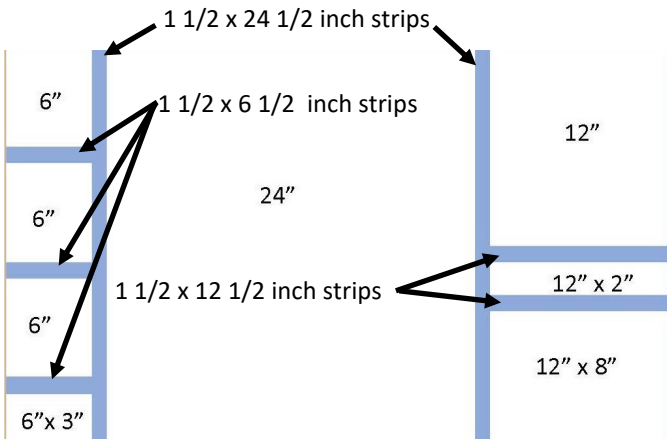
One strip: 1 1/2 x 12 1/2 inches

Two strips: 1 1/2 x 16 1/2 inches

One strip 1 1/2 x 44 1/2 inches

Section 2: Middle Third

Three strips: 1 1/2 x 6 1/2 inches

Two strips: 1 1/2 x 24 1/2 inches

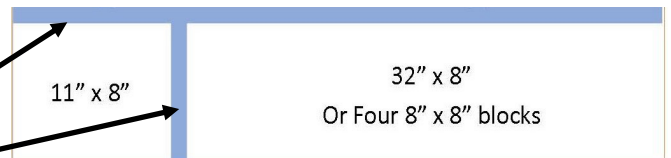
Two Strips: 1 1/2 x 12 1/2 inches

Section 3: Bottom Third

One strip: 1 1/2 x 44 1/2 inches

One strip: 1 1/2 x 8 1/2 inches

Piece your blocks together by Sections. Add sashing starting with the smaller blocks, then adding side sashing to make the entire Section. For Sections 1 and 3, you'll add the 44 1/2 strip last—then you'll sew each Section consecutively.

PLEASE, Bring your quilt to the October meeting—I can't wait to see all the lap quilts in the fabrics you've chose!
