

Block Three

Background Fabric—Cut:

Two—7 3/4 x 7 3/4 inch blocks, cut on the diagonal twice to make Quarter square triangles

Four—5 1/8 x 5 1/8 blocks

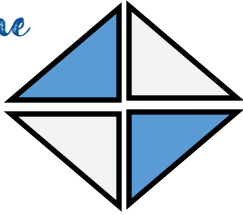
Four—2 x 2 inch blocks

Snowflake/Main Fabric—Cut:

One—6 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch block

Two—7 3/4 x 7 3/4 inch block, cut on the diagonal twice to make Quarter square triangles

Step One

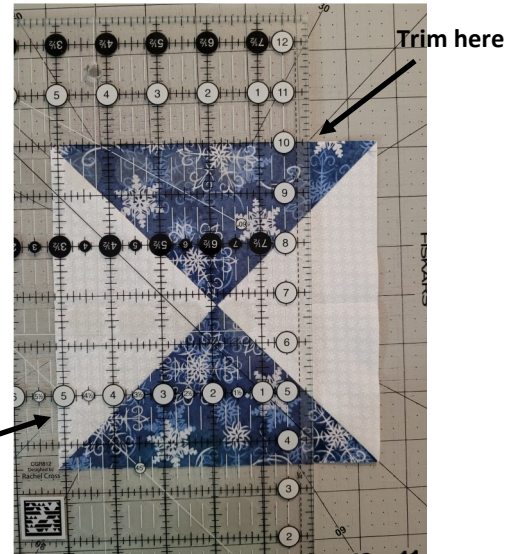


Quarter Square Triangles—using the Background and Main fabric 7 3/4 inch blocks which were cut on the diagonal—make 4 quarter square triangle blocks as shown. I used a scant quarter inch.

Square up all (from middle point 3 1/4) to 6 1/2 inch blocks.

Then, with your Four quarter square triangles, you will trim to **6 1/2 x 5 1/8** inches on **one side of block only**. Example shown.

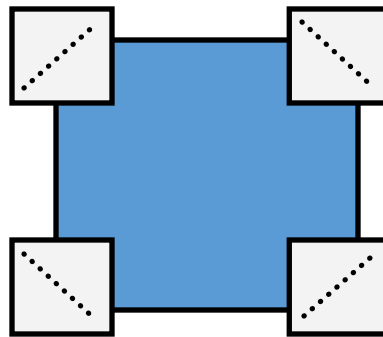
*Cut on the long Background side, not the Snowflake/Main side.



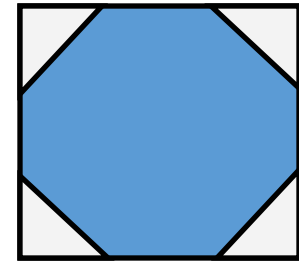
Step Two

For this step, you will need the Snowflake/Main 6 1/2 x 6 1/2 inch square and Four background 2 x 2 squares.

Sew the 2 x 2's on each of the four corners of the 6 1/2 inch square.



This will be your center block



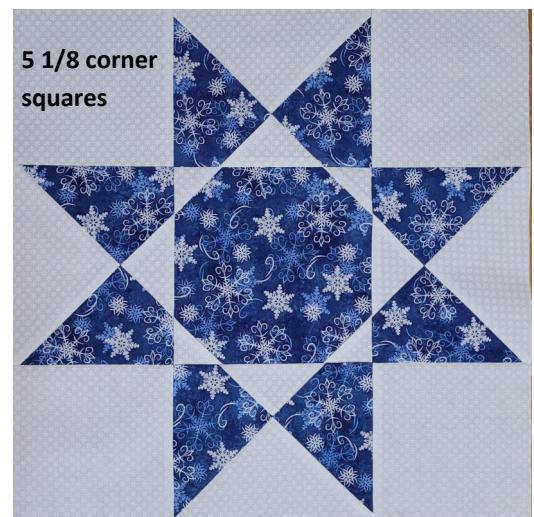
The Finish

This finish will go together like a 9-patch block.

Using the Four—5 1/8 squares, Four trimmed Quarter square blocks and Center.

Row 1 →	5 1/8 background	Step 1	5 1/8
Row 2 →	Step 1	Step 2	Step 1
Row 3 →	5 1/8	Step 1	5 1/8

*Assemble each row as shown to complete the block



Block will finish 15 1/4, unfinished 15 3/4
