## Background Fabric—Cut:

Eight— $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  inch rectangles

Four— $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares

Twenty four— $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$  inch squares

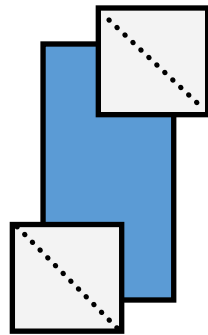
## Snowflake/Main Fabric—Cut:

Twelve— $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$  inch rectangles

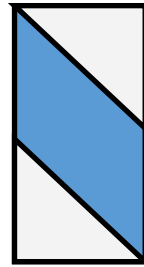
### Step One

Using the Twelve snowflake/main fabric pieces  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ , we'll need to add the Twenty-four background squares to the corners.

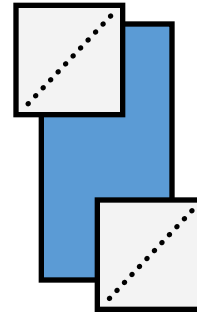
As shown →



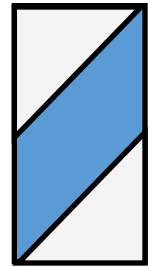
We'll call these Rights



Make a total of Eight



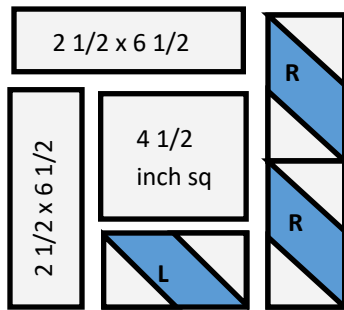
These will be our Lefts



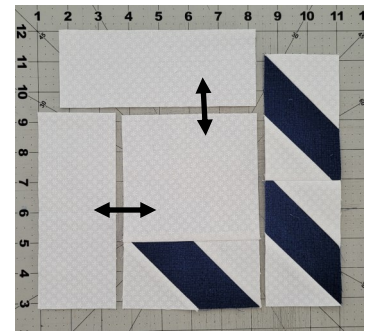
Make a total of Four

### Step Two

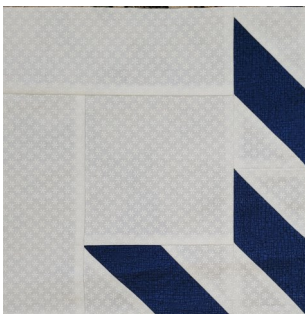
Unit assembly: You will need Two Rights, One Left, Two  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  background rectangles and One  $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$  inch square.



Attach Two Rights together, attach Left to center  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inch square. Add left side  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  inch rectangle, then the top rectangle. Finish the unit by adding the Right units.



### The Finish



Make Four identical units.

With the Four identical units, layout like a compass, with your Rights extending North, South, East and West.



Block will finish 16 inches, unfinished  $16\frac{1}{2}$
