

# Block Twelve

## Background Fabric—Cut:

Twelve—3 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch squares

Four—1 1/2 by 1 1/2 inch squares

## Snowflake/Blue Fabric—Cut:

Two—3 1/2 x 3 1/2 inch squares blocks—darker blue

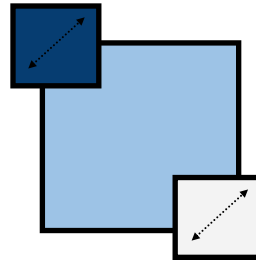
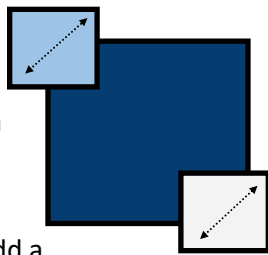
Two—3 1/2 by 3 1/2 inch squares blocks—lighter blue

Eight—1 1/2 x 1 1/2 inch squares —darker blue

Eight—1 1/2 x 1 1/2 inch squares —lighter blue

## Step One

Starting with the center unit, with the dark blue 3 1/2 inch square, add a background 1 1/2 inch square and a lighter blue 1 1/2 inch square to the opposite corners. Do the same with the lighter blue 3 1/2 inch square—add a dark blue and background 1 1/2 inch square to the opposite corners.

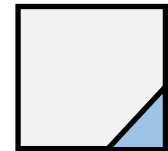
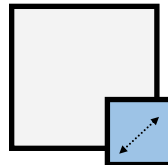
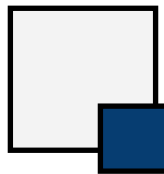


Make 2 of each colorway

## Step Two

Sew a 1 1/2 inch dark blue square to a corner of a 3 1/2 inch background square—make Six background units in this colorway.

With the remaining Six—3 1/2 inch background squares, you'll sew a light blue 1 1/2 inch square to one corner.

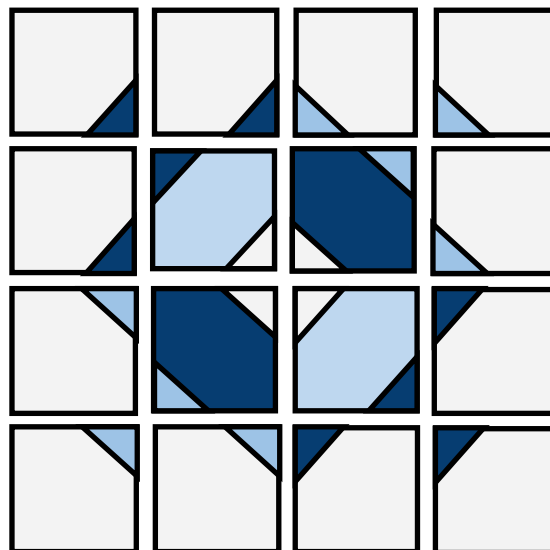


Make 6 of each colorway

## Block Assembly

With flipping and turning, this block is simple and snazzy! Using Step One units, arrange with the background color meeting in the middle/center of finished block. Arrange the Step Two blocks around the center as shown.

Sew blocks into rows, then assemble the rows together.
