

Block Seventeen Half

Background Fabric—Cut:

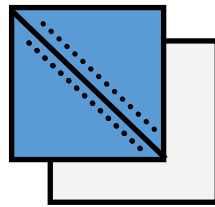
- Two—3 inch x 3 inch squares, HSTs
- Two—2 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch squares
- Two—2 1/2 x 8 1/2 inch rectangles

Snowflake Main Fabric—Cut:

- Five—3 x 3 inch squares
- One—2 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch square

Step One

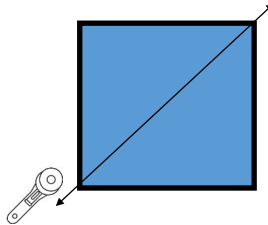
Half Square Triangles—Using just 2 of the 3 inch Snowflake squares and inch Two—3 inch background squares, lay right sides together, draw a line down the center and sew a scant quarter inch sew allowance on each side.



Cut apart, press and square down to 2 1/2 inches, should have 4 total.

Step Two

With the Three remaining 3 inch Snowflake squares, cut on the diagonal.



Block Assembly

Row 5, Once you've completed and sewn together Rows 1 thru 4, add the left row. One—2 1/2 x 8 1/2, One—3 inch square cut on the diagonal

Row 4, One—3 inch square cut on the diagonal

Row 3, One—2 1/2 inch HST, One—3" square cut on the diagonal

Row 2, One—2 1/2 inch Background square, One—2 1/2 inch HST, One—3" square cut on the diagonal

Row 1, One Snowflake 2 1/2 inch square, One Background 2 1/2 inch square, One—2 1/2 inch HST, One—3" square cut on the diagonal

Row 6, One—2 1/2 inch HST, One—2 1/2 x 8 1/2 inch, One—3 inch square cut on the diagonal

Should measure
12 1/2 inches

Should measure
9 1/4 inches
