

Block Twenty Half Pattern by Tina M Darrow

Background Fabric—Cut:

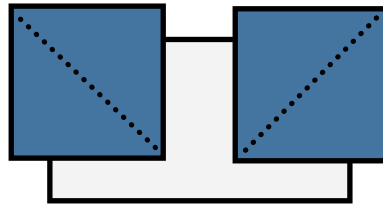
- Three—2 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch squares
- Two—2 1/2 x 4 1/2 inch rectangles

Snowflake/Main Fabric—Cut:

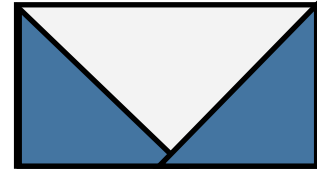
- Two—Dark Blue, 3 x 3 inch squares, cut on diagonal
- Four—Dark Blue, 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch squares
- One—3 3/8 inch square, Square-n-square
- Two—Med Blue, 3 inch squares, cut on diagonal

Step One

Flying Geese—Using the Two 2 1/2 x 4 1/2 inch background rectangles and the Four 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 inch snowflake squares, arrange as shown.



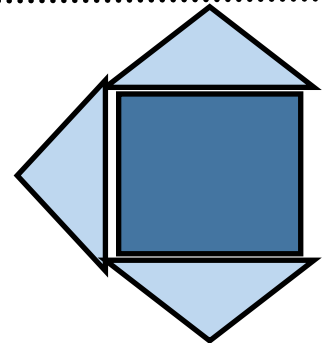
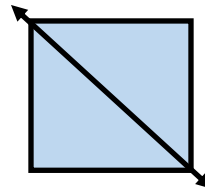
Using One rectangle and Two 2 1/2 inch squares to make One Flying

Step Two

Square in a square—cut Two—3 inch Med Blue squares on the diagonal. Using the 3 3/8 center square (dark blue or print) arrange three units around the square as shown. We're making a not quite a complete Square in a Square. Measure to 4 1/2 inch square.
