Your pre-cuts and any extra fabric

Sewing machine, thread and pre-wound bobbin, regular piecing foot and 1/4" foot

Pins, and just in case, a seam ripper

Rotary cutter (with a new blade) and ruler - 6"x12" works fine

Invisible Scotch Tape (any brand)

fort Plus Floss or any ribbon floss

For Virtual Classes Only:

Small cutting mat 9" x 12" is fine

Highlighter (Pink, green, blue, orange, but NOT yellow)

Add-A-Quarter ruler (the longer the better)

Paper and fabric scissors

Something in which to collect your scraps.

Elmer's Disappearing Purple Glue Stick or any washable, acid free glue stick (online classes only)
