She is the textiles conservator at the Arabia Steamboat Museum in Kansas City, MO.

accuquilt News

This month's featured die is the Alphabet. It cuts 2" high upper-case letters. Although Accuquilt does make a die with lower case letters, they are 3" high to match the 3" upper case letter die which we don't own. For our die, prefuse your fabric and cut into 2 ½" squares to fit over the letters you want to cut. In addition to putting a name on a quilt, use this die to display a message on a pillow or wall hanging. Proclaim JOY along with the angel die. Add FREEDOM to a patriotic quilt. Write a favorite quote. I'm sure you have plenty of ideas.

The Accuquilt cutter will be available at all the guild sew days; let me know which dies you'd like to use. A list of the dies owned by the guild is available on our website. Contact me for a demonstration or to check out our Accuquilt cutter and/or any of our many dies to use at home.


There will be Linus Quilt fabric bags at the Guild Meeting in

It is HOT, so July's fat quarters are **RED**. Solids or prints, as long as the main color is red.


