Andrea LeBeau Lakota Star Quilts "Wichapi Owinza"



Andrea is an enrolled member of the Cheyenne River Sioux Tribe from South Dakota. Andrea has been creating Lakota Starquilts since 2011 and has made over 400 star quilts since. She started her sewing journey as a teenager making Native American Regalia starting the business name "Dancing Dreams Native Designs." Andrea became more interested in making star quilts in 2011 and began to teach herself. She felt it was important as a Lakota woman to become a Lakota quilt maker because of the history of the Lakota Star quilt. In 2015, Andrea created the Facebook group "Starquilt tips and Tricks." Andrea's goal was to provide a space to others for learning as she did not have others teach her how to make Star Quilts. To date, there are over 9,000 members of the group, both learners and longtime quilt makers and it is still active. She has also spent time teaching individuals privately on how to make Star Quilts.

Andrea's favorite thing about making star quilts is seeing the process start as simple cut fabrics to a beautiful piece of art. She also enjoys creating color schemes for the star quilts.

Andrea will be sharing the history of Lakota Starquilts, also known as Lone Star Quilts, and the significance of the quilt in the Native American community.


accuquilt News
